A14 motorway Mestre bypass opened for traffic

On Sunday 8 February 2009, at the presence of the highest offices of Italian Government, the A14 motorway Mestre bypass has been opened for traffic only four years after the beginning of the works for its realisation.

This new motorway stretch, an alternative to the existing ring-road of Mestre, has a length of 32,5 km and is made of three lanes plus an emergency lane for each way. The Work consists mainly of 4 viaducts, 4 cut & cover tunnels, 4 river crossings with one span bridges, 15 overpasses and 22 underpasses of the existing motorway networks.

The value of works executed by Cmc, within the general contractor "Passante di Mestre SCpA", is about 74 million Euros.
