

Cmc di Ravenna: revenues 2013 towards one billion euro

Today CMC reported financial data concerning the first half of 2013 and the forecast year-end.

In the first six months, revenues totaled 472.3 million, with a pre-tax profit of 13.1 million.
60% of revenues gets from foreign operations.

The Cooperative expects year-end revenues of about 1 billion.

Significant amounts are produced in the Expo and the Milan external eastern by-pass (TEM) yards.

Stable employment, with 8,227 units deployed at 30 June.
The order portfolio amount is 3.3 billion euro.

Today the new acquisitions amount to approximately 844 million, whose 656 million from overseas operations.
There has been significant new contracts in Algeria and Libya (highways), China, India and Nepal (underground works), South Africa.

CMC also acquired a stake into Di Fazio Industries construction company based in New York; which allows CMC to expand its actual presence in the United States.

Although the Italian market has increasing difficulties, CMC is accomplishing several ongoing acquisitions, among which the maritime works in the port of Piombino with the view to a possible transfer of the Costa Concordia must be reported.
