

## **Cmc di Ravenna wins 240 and 120 million-euro contracts in Kenya and in Sicily**

CMC di Ravenna is awarded two new contracts worth approximately €240 million and €120 million, respectively.

Most particular in Kenya, the Employer “Rift Valley Water Service Board” has awarded to CMC di Ravenna, the main cooperative in the field of construction in Europe with a turnover in excess of 1 billion Euro (2013), the works for the construction of the Itari dam and the relevant Water Treatment Plant for an amount of approximately €240 million.

During the next months the Export Credit to finance the works will be finalized by Italian banks.

In Sicily CMC, in association with Coopsette, has been awarded (has signed) two contracts for the Metro Circumetnea development project in Catania, concerning the execution of the Stesicoro-Airport and Nesima-Misterbianco sections.

The total value of the works is €139 million, 122 million of which pertain to CMC.

The tunnels to a total length of approximately 3.9 km, will be excavated by two Tunnel Boring Machines (TBM) of 10 metres diameter.
